



The Forgotten Children

Target Group:

The Level 2 training is applicable to voluntary, statutory and independent agencies that work with or have responsibility for children, young people and their families in Telford & Wrekin.

It is a criteria for attendance on this course that applicants must have completed a Safeguarding Children Board, Raising Awareness in Child Protection session prior to attending this course.

Aim:

Privately Fostered Children have been identified in the 2004 Children act as a particular group of children who are in need of safeguarding. This session will highlight the particular factors practitioners need to be aware of in identifying and working with these children and their carers, by exploring the responsibility of Children's Services

Objectives:

- To define Private Fostered Care arrangements
- To explore the need for such placements to be assessed by the Private Fostering Social Worker
- To raise awareness of the key issues for children and young people who are Privately Fostered
- Consider the vulnerability factors of these children
- Identify requirements of the Telford & Wrekin Safeguarding Children Board, for practitioners to respond to these children and their carers
